Interviews took place between the years 2000-2005. These tribes are noted as former inhabitants of the Rocky Mountain National Park area. Interviews took place between the years 2000-2005. These tribes are noted as former inhabitants of the Rocky Mountain National Park area. This information fulfills the Rocky Mountain National Park's responsibility to understand traditional uses of the area, and to capture memories and stories of Native American's in the area.

Scope

Oral history includes interviews, with transcripts. Bilingual transcripts and language notes are also included in some series. Correspondence includes emails, personal letters to and from Sally McBeth, newspaper clippings, photographs and multimedia. Release forms accompanied all oral transcriptions. A final report of the project, along with notes on tribal contacts, is included.
